#### Maehara Stadium Updates

The Maui County Permits office has reached out to the MABL for June dates including the championship series and ASG/HRD. Outdoor sporting events are currently restricted to 100 people (updated to 200 people on 6/16) and the league will monitor capacity using predistributed tickets. The MABL hopes to retain permits for the stadium through the summer season.

### MABL Game Balls

60 dozen customized flat seamed baseballs were ordered for \$69.99 per dozen. The baseballs have Commissioner Abercrombie's signature and the MABL logo. This is enough baseballs for 2 seasons. As the league is waiting for season dues to arrive, Commissioner Abercrombie paid for the baseballs himself to be reimbursed at a later date.

### **Championship Trophy**

A \$66 placeholder trophy has been purchased from Edco to use this championship series. The board is looking for a custom palm tree trophy to be crafted by the end of the 2021 season.

## Home Run Derby

The Home Run Derby will be June 27<sup>th</sup> and feature a new prize for the champion, a custom MABL heavyweight belt. The winner will also be awarded a custom bat at \$140 value.

## Umpire Clinic

The league, along with help of Umpire Jaime will be hosting an umpire clinic the weekend of July 11<sup>th</sup>. The MABL will pay for Jaime's flight from California to host the clinic here on Maui. It will be mandatory for all umpires to participate in the summer 2021 season. It will be a 3 day clinic covering rules, drills, simulated game scenarios and drills. Food will be provided for the participants.

# Lineup Rule Review

In a 10 spot lineup with the 10<sup>th</sup> spot being an A/B there is a question of what happens if a player not in the 10<sup>th</sup> spot needs to leave. Is the A/B spot broken up into two individual slots to retain the 10 spot, or move to a 9 spot lineup and retain the A/B. The board suggested the A/B spot be broken up to keep the 10 man structure. The board will propose an amendment to managers before next season.
